

As the new MHF chaplain, Br Stephen visited many MHF families, and, pursuing his calling as an evangelist, fruitfully journeyed throughout Pakistan, and even into Iran, sharing the love of Jesus, giving out audio gospels and baptising new believers.

MHF support Jaranwala victims: Brother Nicholas, our Pakistan Administrator, organised 30 boxes of food aid to relieve the suffering of the Christian villagers of Jaranawala. Militant Islamists had set fire to their homes, churches and schools following a spurious charge of blasphemy. Br Nicholas, who lives nearby, stepped in to help clear up, to counsel the homeless villagers and supply boxes of essential food and water to relieve their suffering.

New administrator for MHF Kenya: Pastor Dickson, eminent church leader and Bible College teacher, also serves Christ in the slums of Nairobi. His passion for business and Christian ministry combine in his enthusiastic delivery of MHF Pilot Poultry Project. Rev Samwel, Francis and Reuben have received in-depth training. The next step is to supply materials for each to build a hen coop to farm 20 birds. This initiative for sustainable chicken farming in Kenya will feed their dependents, and ultimately develop communities.
